#### **TANZANIA OVERVIEW**

#### **Economy and Infrastructure**

Tanzania's economy is largely dependent on agriculture, which employs about 75% of its population. An estimated 34% of tanzanians currently live in poverty. The economy has been transitioning from a command economy to a market economy since 1985. Although total GDP has increased since these reforms began, GDP per capita dropped sharply at first, and only exceeded the pre-transition figure in around 2007.

#### **External Trade and Investment**

Tanzania's history of political stability has encouraged foreign direct investment. The government has committed itself to improve the investment climate including redrawing tax codes, floating the exchange rate, licensing foreign banks, and creating an investment promotion center to cut red tape. Tanzania has mineral resources and a largely untapped tourism sector, which would make it a viable market for foreign investment.

#### VISA

Usually visa is available at the airport on arrival for all nationalities except few countries including Afghanistan - Bangladesh - Iran - Iraq - Pakistan - Palestine - Sri Lanka - Sudan Somalia - Nigeria Uzbekistan Lebanon Ethiopia etc. These nationalities are advised to contact the organizer for visa application at least 2-months prior to the exhibition. We can also assist in processing of entry visas for all the exhibitors and trade visitors, particularly of nationalities whose countries high commission are not present in Tanzania.
